



SHIPPING HAZARDOUS GOODS T&Cs

Service Availability and Cargo Acceptance

Our ability to provide shipping services for hazardous goods is contingent upon the **availability of appropriate equipment** and the **acceptance of such cargo by the selected shipping line**. Both factors will be confirmed once we receive your order along with a copy of the required transport document, the **Multimodal Dangerous Goods Form (MDGF)**

Safety Verification for Peace of Mind

To ensure the safe and compliant transportation of your hazardous goods, our certified **Dangerous Goods Safety Advisor** will thoroughly review the MDGF upon receipt of your order. Please note that this safety check is conducted **after your order is placed** and cannot be included as part of the initial price quotation process

Incompatibility and Dispatch Timing for Hazardous Cargo

Due to stringent safety regulations, certain hazardous goods may be **incompatible with other cargo** already booked or belonging to **different classes** that cannot be shipped together in the same vehicle. When such situations arise, we will prioritize safety by arranging **separate shipments**, which could affect scheduling and logistics. This may result in **temporary restrictions** on dispatch timing. We will assess compatibility upon receiving your order and advise you of any necessary adjustments to ensure the **safe and timely transport of your goods**.

Restrictions on Specific Hazardous Goods

We prioritize safety and compliance in all our operations. Therefore, please be aware that we are unable to ship goods classified under **Class 1 (explosives)** and **Class 7 (radioactive materials)**, as well as goods that fall under **Packing Group I**, which denotes substances with the highest level of danger.
